### **MEANING – What does it mean?**

3. What's Paul's point in verse 1?
4. In verse 2-4 we're told to boast (or rejoice). What are we to boast in? Why?
5. How does Paul emphasize God's love for us in verses 6-8? What's his point?
6. How does our knowledge about what God has done in the past give us confidence and assurance into the future (9-11)? Put verse 9 into your own words.

### **APPLICATION – How does it change us?**

7. How would you answer someone who says, "I'm a Christian but I'm not completely sure I'll be saved on judgement day"?
8. What are some ways we can "boast in our suffering" when it comes our way?
9. How does knowing you have peace with God change the way you're going to live this week?
