### APPLICATION – How does it change us?

- 7. How does knowing there is now no condemnation for us change the way we see our:
  - Guilty feelings because of sin?
  - Baggage we carry that Jesus has died for?
- 8. How does this passage change the way we see our "nice" friends who don't know Jesus? How does it help us to pray for them?
- 9. What are some practical ways we can live in accordance with the Spirit and have our minds set on what the Spirit desires?
