- 7. What does verse 51 mean? (Have a look at Genesis 28:10-12)

## APPLICATION – How does it change us?

- 8. The disciples hear about Jesus and can't help but want to tell everyone who is dear to them. How can we re-discover our enthusiasm for telling people about Jesus?
- 9. If Jesus is the lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world, and we truly believe that how does this amazing truth affect how we relate to:
