- 5. What obligation is there for those who have the Spirit? What does that mean for us?
- 6. List some of the amazing privileges that are ours if we have the Spirit.

- 7. What are some ways we can "put to death the misdeeds of the body"?
- 8. How does this passage give assurance to Christians who are struggling with sin?
- 9. How does this passage teach us to:
 - Encourage each other?
