

STUDY 5 Give us today our daily bread

How would you answer someone who says, "God wants me to be rich so I'm going to live my life to make money"?

- 1. **Read Proverbs 30:7-9** What are the two extremes the writer asks the Lord to keep him from? What are his reasons for asking this? What do you think "daily bread" means here?
- 2. **Read Matthew 6:19-34** What reason does Jesus give for not storing up treasure on earth? What does verse 21 mean?
- 3. Why do you think Jesus talks about eyes, light and darkness in vv.22-23, in the middle of talking money and treasures?
- 4. <u>Have another look at Matthew 6:25-34</u> How does this help us when we're worried about life and money?
- 5. Praying "give us today our daily bread" is asking God to give us what we need and not riches or poverty
  - How is this a challenging prayer?
  - How does <u>Matthew 6:19-34</u> shape this prayer?
  - How can we live this prayer with our priorities? Our money? Our decision making?
