- 4. What does God seek and what does He give according to these verses? How does Jesus these purposes of God?
- 5. What is the "living water" and how do we get it?
- 6. What Jesus mean in verse 23 when he says, "true worshippers will worship the Father in Spirit and in truth"?
- 7. Read 4:39-42. What does this tell us about Jesus and who he is?

APPLICATION – How does it change us?

- 8. Jesus brings in God's new age of the Spirit and truth now, through his death and resurrection. How does this encourage us to keep trusting Him?
- 9. How can we live as true worshippers of God (according to this passage)?
- 10. Jesus is the Saviour of the world what are some ways we can show He is our Saviour each day?
