STUDY 15 Romans 8:31-39

God is for us

1. Read Romans 8:1-30. Now read Romans 8:31-39. How does Paul link the two passages?

OBSERVATION – How is it communicated?

2. What are any key words or phrases that stand out to you from Romans 8:31-39

MEANING – What does it mean?

3. How can we know for sure that God is for us?
4. What kind of opposition does Paul suggest might make us fearful or doubt God's love?
5. What are the three questions in vv. 33, 34, 35 and how do the answers help us as Christians?
6. How are we "more than conquerors through him who loved us"?

APPLICATION – How does it change us?

7. What would you say to someone who says:

"I don't feel like God is for me"

"I sometimes doubt God's love for me is real"

8. Have another look over Romans 8 and note down anything God has spoken to you from this amazing chapter. Share your encouragements.
